



Stage 1 Water Restrictions Are In Effect

Stage 1 Water Restrictions for GVSUD customers went into effect and were posted to our website on April 7th.

Stage 1 Water Restrictions Require the Following:

Sprinkler or irrigation systems may water two (2) days per week BEFORE 10:00 a.m. or AFTER 8:00 p.m.

The watering schedule is based on the last digit of your address:

Even numbers (0, 2, 4, 6, 8) - Watering days are Monday and Thursday

Odd numbers (1, 3, 5, 7, 9) - Watering days are Tuesday and Friday

You can use handheld hoses, buckets, drop irrigation systems, and soaker hoses that do not spray water in the air at any time. Excessive water use is prohibited on any day.



Tips to Limit Outdoor Water Usage

Check and adjust your irrigation system

- Please set your system to provide thorough but infrequent watering. Check sprinkler heads regularly to make sure they are working correctly. Install rain shut-off devices and adjust sprinklers to eliminate coverage on the pavement.
- For plants that require more frequent watering, use a hose or watering can to give them additional water.

Prevent evaporation of water

- Water early in the morning and avoid windy days.
- Use drip irrigation systems for bedded plants, trees, or shrubs and use low-angle sprinklers for yards.
- Cover pools and spas to prevent excessive evaporation; doing this can save the equivalent of your pool volume each year!

Tips to Conserve Indoor Water Usage

Bathroom

- Check toilets for leaks. Take the top off your toilet tank and add a few drops of food coloring or a dye tablet to the water in the tank. Do not flush the toilet. If the color appears in the bowl within a few minutes, the toilet has a leak that most likely can be fixed by replacing the flapper or rubber washer. Cheap fix, huge savings.

Kitchen

- Run the dishwasher only when it is full. If your machine has a quick wash or light duty setting, use it!
- Use garbage disposals sparingly. They can waste water unnecessarily.

Laundry

- Wash only full loads.
- Use the lowest water level setting on the washing machine for light or partial loads whenever possible.
