First Community Outreach Program – “Source to Tap” Presentation, Lauded a Success

Community Outreach Program to Educate and Build Awareness of Today’s Rural Water Systems

GVSUD and Canyon Regional Water Authority (CRWA)’s Emerging Leaders partnered to host a “Source to Tap” presentation at CRWA’s Lake Dunlap on Wednesday, September 1st. The event provided an overview on sourcing, treating, and distributing safe, clean drinking water to Green Valley’s customers. Attendees saw detailed graphics illustrating CRWA’s various delivery points and the distribution points that reach GVSUD customers throughout the 94,000 acres serviced by the company.

The event consisted of two tours and a Powerpoint presentation. The first tour was of the surface water treatment facility in New Braunfels at Lake Dunlap, where attendees could walk through the facility and see each step of the treatment process. The second tour featured the groundwater treatment facility at Wells Ranch in Seguin, which included a step-by-step video of the process.

The customers and co-workers who attended provided great feedback about the expertise and knowledge shared during the tours and presentation. Many “ah-ha” moments occurred, and attendees asked engaging questions.

Committed to Safe, Clean Water

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) establish all quality guidelines and regulate tap water in Texas. The EPA created the Safe Drinking Water Act and has established protected drinking water standards that address more than 90 contaminants. The TCEQ also sets and implements measures for safe drinking water to improve and maintain water quality in Texas. CRWA and GVSUD’s treatment plants, wells, and distribution sites all exceed the minimum standards put into place by both EPA and TCEQ.

**Stage 1 Water Restrictions Effective
September 1st**

During Stage 1 Water Restrictions, declared September 1st, customers are required to adhere to the following:

During the current drought conditions, watering with an irrigation system or sprinkler is allowed twice a week between the hours of 12:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to midnight. The water days are based on the last digit of your address.

- Even Numbers (0, 2, 4, 6, 8) - MONDAY AND THURSDAY
- Odd Numbers (1, 3, 5, 7, 9) - TUESDAY AND FRIDAY

Handheld hose, buckets, drip irrigation systems, and soaker hose that do not spray water in the air are permitted any time. Excessive water use is prohibited on any day. All customers are requested to practice water conservation and discontinue all non-essential water uses.

As drought conditions continue, it may be necessary to move to Stage 2 Water Restrictions. Once Stage 2 Water Restrictions are declared, a notice will be posted to our website www.GVSUD.org and included with the next billing statement.
