



# STAGE 3 WATER RESTRICTIONS RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL EFFECTIVE: Monday, July 18, 2022 Aquifer Trigger Level ~ 640 FEET

Green Valley Special Utility District (GVSUD) General Manager, Pat Allen, has initiated Stage 3 Water Restrictions of the GVSUD Drought Contingency Plan. GVSUD is requiring all customers to reduce water use by 35%.

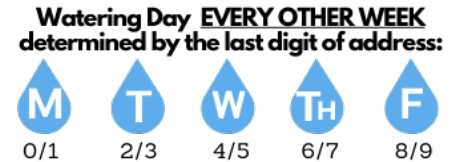
During Stage 3 Water Restriction customers are required to adhere to the following:

Sprinkler or irrigation systems may water **one (1) day EVERY OTHER WEEK** beginning on Monday after Stage 3 has been initiated.

**BEFORE 10:00 a.m. or AFTER 8:00 p.m.**  
Based on the last digit of your address



- **Monday** 0 or 1
- **Tuesday** 2 or 3
- **Wednesday** 4 or 5
- **Thursday** 6 or 7
- **Friday** 8 or 9



- **If there is no street address associated with the property, such as a parkway, or if there is more than one street address associated with a single contiguous property, the watering day is Wednesday.**

Handheld hoses, buckets, drip irrigation systems, and soaker hoses that do not spray water in the air are permitted on **Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, BEFORE 10:00 am or AFTER 8:00 pm. Excessive water usage is prohibited.**

All customers are requested to practice water conservation and discontinue all non-essential water uses.

The following is **NOT ALLOWED** during Stage 3 Water Restrictions:

Vehicle washing at home, filling or refilling of swimming pools, use of aesthetic fountains or pools.

Waivers/variances for new lawns must be approved by the District.

As drought conditions continue, it may be necessary to move to Stage 4 Water Restrictions. Once Stage 4 Water Restrictions are declared a notice will be posted on our website [www.GVSUD.org](http://www.GVSUD.org) and the notice mailed with the next billing statement.
