

STAGE 2 WATER RESTRICTIONS RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL As Of June 13, 2018

It is imperative that <u>ALL</u> GVSUD customers <u>CONSERVE WATER REGARDLESS OF ITS SOURCE</u> AND <u>DISCONTINUE NON-ESSENTIAL WATER USES.</u>

During the current drought conditions, watering with an irrigation system or sprinkler is **PERMITTED ONLY ONCE A WEEK**, **ON THE DESIGNATED WATERING DAY**, between the hours of 12:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to midnight.

The watering days are based on the last digit of your address.

- O OR 1 MONDAY
 2 OR 3 TUESDAY
 4 OR 5 WEDNESDAY
 6 OR 7 THURSDAY
 8 OR 9 FRIDAY
- > If there is no street address associated with the property, such as a parkway, or if there is more than one street address associated with a single contiguous property, watering day is Wednesday.

Excessive water usage is prohibited. Soaker hoses, handheld hoses, drip irrigation systems or 5 gallon buckets are allowed on any day between the hours of 12:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to midnight.

GVSUD will implement restrictions based on the Edwards Aquifer Authority Critical Period Triggers. San Antonio's newspaper, radio and television stations, as well as the internet, will provide daily aquifer and spring flow levels.

As drought conditions continue, citations may be issued to customers who do not follow water conservation guidelines. GVSUD will turn water off if excessive water wasting is found.
