The GREEN VALLEY SUD water system PWS ID 0940020 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

These violations occurred in the monitoring periods 2nd Quarter 2018.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

All water was properly disinfected prior to entering the distribution system and maintained acceptable residuals throughout the system. All samples for the 2nd Quarter were collected in a timely manner. The report was submitted to TCEQ after the due date. Administrative changes have been made to ensure all future reports are submitted electronically and in a timely manner.
