Phillip “Phil” K. Gage serves as the General Manager of Green Valley Special Utility District (GVSUD) since June 2024. As the General Manager, Mr. Gage reports to the Board of Directors as the principle executive spearheading strategic development and growth, resource management and fiscal responsibility, and developing a customer centric culture of service for the District.

Phil is a native Texan from Diboll, Texas. He is a retired Army Colonel and combat veteran of the U.S. Army completing a 32 year career in May 2024. He has served in numerous leadership roles at every level over the years, and has served overseas in Korea, Saudi Arabia, Germany, and Japan, as well as completing four combat tours in both Iraq and Afghanistan.

Phil commanded the U.S. Army Garrison Japan from 2017 to 2019 at Camp Zama, Japan. As commander, he was responsible for 15 installations or “municipalities” across Japan supporting the U.S. Army in Japan, and the Soldiers, Families, and Civilians serving throughout the country. In this role, Phil was responsible for utilities, facilities maintenance, emergency services, disaster preparedness, strategic relationships, and fiscal responsibility for an annual budget of over \$160M.

Phil holds a Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Development from Texas A&M University, College Station, Texas and a Master of Science in Adult Occupational Education from Kansas State University, Manhattan, Kansas. He is a graduate of the U.S. Army War College, Carlisle, Pennsylvania, and holds a Master of Strategic Studies from that institution.
